Today's liturgy speaks of two families. The first is the family that consists of parents and children: "The shepherds...found Mary and Joseph, and the baby lying in a manger." The first two readings are about the qualities of the people who make up such a family, and we pray that God may "unite our families in peace and love." We also pray that God may "help us to live as the holy family, united in respect and love." Here the liturgy concerns the human family, of which the Holy Family is also a model: "we want to live as Jesus, Mary, and Joseph, in peace with you and one another." Perhaps now more than ever, we need to beg God to" show us the value of family life and help us to live in peace with all people."

A happy and peaceful Christmas to all our Parishioners and to all who are visiting our parish at this time. Serving in the parish we are continually encouraged and edified by those who worship with us. At Christmas we remember that God has come near to us in Jesus Christ, our 'Emmanuel'. It is a time when we are reminded of the hope that we experience through the coming of our Saviour. The heart of the Christmas story is that, in Jesus, 'God has visited his people'.
