



The priest and pastoral staff from Chinese Martyrs will be taking responsibility for the pastoral ministry for this community. The mass will take place on Saturdays at 7pm except at times when the church is needed for special feasts (i.e. Easter Vigil, etc.). It will begin this Saturday, December 8th, during the season of Advent - a time of waiting and hoping and welcoming the stranger into our community. 
Singing for Christmas

Or simply say "Peace be with you" without any gesture.
