
#### Welcoming the Stranger

#### The Sign of Peace




During the cold and flu season, some people have asked to express the sign of peace in a manner other than shaking hands. The General Instruction of the Roman Missal does not specify a particular manner of offering a sign of peace. Thus, if because of medical conditions or personal

sensibilities, you wish for an alternate method of exchanging peace, you are welcome to choose instead to either make a reverential bow of your head to the people around you and say, "Peace be with you." Or simply say "Peace be with you" without any gesture.
