#### **2019 Offertory Envelopes**



We have had a few people inquire about offertory envelope numbers being changed. It may be helpful for you to under-

stand what happens in the office regarding these envelopes. In every parish, people join and others leave, they become inactive due to life circumstances and they change their giving patterns (e.g. stop using envelopes, move to pre-authorized giving). When this happens, "gaps" are left in the numbering sequence. When we purchase envelopes, we receive them in sequential order. This means that if we never reassign the numbers, we are purchasing envelopes that will never be used. This is wasteful of both paper and money, so we consolidate the numbers. Some of the "gaps" however, are caused by people not picking up their envelopes in a timely fashion. So we appeal to you to help us in two ways. Please pick up your offertory envelopes as soon as possible. This will minimize the quantity of envelope numbers we need to be reassigned. Secondly, please be understanding if you do receive a new envelope number. Remember that "in Christ all things become new." If you happen to be one of those who gets a new number, use it as an opportunity to celebrate this wonderful reality!
