The Christian Reaction to Failure: Among the many lessons Jesus s teaches about how to be a Christian, the last one in today's gospel is often overlooked. After encouraging them to work hard, because the harvest is ready; to be ready for difficulties, because there are wolves out there; to put their confidence in God, not in money or in their own strength; to stay focused on their mission and not be dis-

tracted; After all of that, he finishes his instructions by telling his disciples how to react when they are rejected, when their efforts appear fruitless, when they seem to fail in their attempts to win people over to Christ. When that happens, they are simply to shake the dust from their feet and move on. Jesus is telling his disciples, and that includes all of us, to expect failures as we try to live out and spread the Gospel, and not to let it bother us.






Offertory Counters

Something Changing This Way Comes

As of **June 26**, our parish now has only one priest. The reality of fewer priests, which is already being experienced in many parts of the world, is now being seen in our Archdiocese. This will mean necessary changes to some aspects of parish life. We can meet this change as an obstacle or as an opportunity to grow. Please help by being patient, understanding and "not sweating the small stuff." To ensure that Fr. Efren is available for funerals. weddings, school and nursing home masses, there will be immediate changes to the daily mass schedule including the omission of one daily mass, to allow for one necessary day off. Watch this weekly bulletin as we continue to communicate with you our plans for managing this change. The following are changes that will be in effect starting July 1:

◆ There will be **no masses** on Mondays, including holidays.

- ◆ The mass of anointing will be offered approximately every 3 months and they will be announced a few weeks in advance.
- All Friday masses will all be at 7pm and confessions will be offered after mass every Friday. Confessions will no longer be heard on Saturday mornings.
