

WORLD DAY OF THE SICK



Begun in 1992 by St. Pope John Paul II and celebrated each year on February 11, Memorial of Our Lady of Lourdes, this is the 28th World Day of the Sick. For resources such as the Pope's Message for 2020, visit Care for the Sick website at: www.archtoronto.org/sick The theme this year is: You received without payment; give without payment (Matthew 10:8)

In cases where there is an urgent need for a priest at the hospital, the Archdiocese has implemented a system which ensures that those who need the Sacrament of the Sick are able to get it in a timely fashion. If you are in urgent need of a priest, do not call the priest directly. Rather, speak to the nurse on duty. The nurse will speak to the hospital Chaplain or contact the person in charge. All the priests in the area take turns being on call. They are assigned a 24-hour pager through which they can be contacted immediately. Often, valuable time is wasted with families trying to get in touch with a specific priest. This puts our loved one in danger of not receiving the Sacrament of the Sick. We appreciate you following this protocol in helping us serve those who are ill and in urgent need of the Sacrament of the Sick.
