



Until at least **May 20**, 2021, as part of an extended stay-at-home order, the following restrictions are in place:

• Parishes must restrict attendance inside the church to 10

- people, including priests.
- Public Masses must be temporarily cancelled.
- Churches, wherever possible are encouraged to remain open for private prayer.
- Weddings, funerals, baptisms and reconciliation are restricted to 10 persons, including priest, cantor, etc.
- First Holy Communion and Confirmation are postponed at this time.
- The office will be closed to the public and staff will continue working remotely.
- Elderly parishioners, those with compromised immune systems or other health conditions are strongly encouraged to remain at home and the dispensation from the Sunday Eucharist remains.






