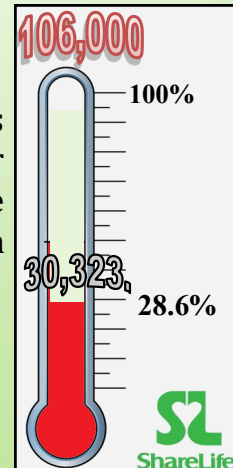

The Holy Spirit in Mary's Life



The Blessed Virgin received the Holy Spirit at Pentecost with a unique fulness. This was so because her heart was the purest, the freest, the heart which most incomparably loved the most Blessed Trinity. Our Lord had promised to those who loved God "we will come to him and make our home with him." (John 14:23) This promise was fulfilled above all in Our Lady. God prepared her with immense care by the Holy Spirit to be the living tabernacle of the Son of God. At the Annunciation, the Archangel Gabriel greets her, "Hail full of grace." (Luke 1:28) "Our Lady is endowed with the high office and dignity of the Mother of the Son of God, and therefore she is the beloved daughter of the Father and the temple of the Holy Spirit." (Lumen gentium, 53) The only Spirit, who had lived in Mary since the mystery of the Immaculate Conception, came on the day of Pentecost to dwell in her in a new way. All the promises Jesus had made about the Paraclete are fully accomplished in the soul of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

Holy Mary, Mother of the Church, pray for us

Communication for Parish Volunteers re: Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act (AODA)

The Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act (AODA) is an Ontario law enacted in 2005, mandating that organizations follow standards to become more accessible to people with disabilities. The goal for the province is to be fully accessible by 2025 by removing barriers in a number of areas. All levels of government, private sectors, and non-profits must comply with this legislation.

Since 2012, the Archdiocese of Toronto has been implementing the required standards of the AODA as they become law and are committed to providing a welcoming, accessible and inclusive environment for all of its parishioners, visitors, volunteers and employees. The AODA aligns with the Archdiocese's desire to be of service, equitable and socially responsible.

As the Archdiocese is considered a large organization under the AODA, part of the requirement is to provide a copy of the Archdiocese of Toronto's AODA Customer Service Policy and to provide AODA training to all clergy, employees, independent contractors and volunteers – including paid and unpaid positions – regardless of whether they have contact with the public. This requirement is for individuals ages 16+. As well, the Archdiocese must keep records of training.

As a valued volunteer of the Archdiocese of Toronto and in keeping with the Canadian Code for Volunteer Involvement, you have a right to expect sufficient training in order to accomplish your volunteer ministry. You also have the responsibility to complete the required training and comply with the training you receive.

We are asking our volunteers to please take the time to read over the policy and complete the training in a timely manner.

The OADA Training Manual can be found on the [Archdiocese of Toronto Volunteer Screening Program - Orientation & Training](#) website. Then select the AODA Online Training Modules. The last part will be completing the SurveyMonkey Acknowledgment as the Archdiocese must keep records of training.
