

#### IMPORTANT MESSAGE TO ALL ST JOHN CHRYSOSTOM VOLUNTEERS



Under the Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act (2005), the Archdiocese of Toronto, is required to train all existing and new volunteers, on the accessibility law requirements (including AODA and the Ontario Human Rights

Code), that apply to their duties and our organization, to serve customers of all abilities. They also keep and maintain a record of when training is provided, including dates and the number of individuals trained, by having the volunteers complete the SurveyMonkey at the end of their online training. ## THE VISITATION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY



On May 31st the Church celebrates the feast of the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The feast was established by Pope Urban VI in 1389. The date is located between Our Lord's Annunciation (March 25th) and the birth of John the Baptist (June 24th), in keeping with what we read in the Gospel of Luke. It commemorates Our Lady's visit to her cousin Elizabeth, who was already advanced in years, to help her during

the period of her pregnancy and at the same time to share with her the jubilation at the wonders wrought by God in both of them. This feast, with which we close the month dedicated to Mary, proclaims to us her mediation, her spirit of service and her profound humility. It teaches us to carry the spirit of Christian happiness with wherever we go, so that, like Mary, we shall be continually a source of joy for all peoples.

At Mary's arrival Elizabeth is filled with the Holy Spirit-and proclaims in a loud voice: "Blessed are you among woman, and Blessed is the fruit of your womb! And why is this granted me, that the mother of my Lord should come to Me? For behold, when the voice of your greeting came to my ears, the babe in my womb leaped for joy." (Lk 1: 42-44)

## Communication for Parish Volunteers re: Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act (AODA)

The Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act (AODA) is an Ontario law enacted in 2005, mandating that organizations follow standards to become more accessible to people with disabilities. The goal for the province is to be fully accessible by 2025 by removing barriers in a number of areas. All levels of government, private sectors, and non-profits must comply with this legislation.

Since 2012, the Archdiocese of Toronto has been implementing the required standards of the AODA as they become law and are committed to providing a welcoming, accessible and inclusive environment for all of its parishioners, visitors, volunteers and employees. The AODA aligns with the Archdiocese's desire to be of service, equitable and socially responsible.

As the Archdiocese is considered a large organization under the AODA, part of the requirement is to provide a copy of the Archdiocese of Toronto's AODA Customer Service Policy and to provide AODA training to all clergy, employees, independent contractors and volunteers – including paid and unpaid positions – regardless of whether they have contact with the public. This requirement is for individuals ages 16+. As well, the Archdiocese must keep records of training.

As a valued volunteer of the Archdiocese of Toronto and in keeping with the Canadian Code for Volunteer Involvement, you have a right to expect sufficient training in order to accomplish your volunteer ministry. You also have the responsibility to complete the required training and comply with the training you receive.

On our parish website at <u>Accessibility</u> you will find the **Archdiocese of Toronto's AODA Accessible Customer Service Policy.** 

We are asking our volunteers to please take the time to read over the policy and complete the training in a timely manner.

The OADA Training Manual can be found on the <u>Archdiocese of Toronto Volunteer Screening Program - Orientation & Training</u> website. Then select the AODA Online Training Modules. The last part will be completing the SurveyMonkey Acknowledgment as the Archdiocese must keep records of training.
