It was for his sermons that Saint John earned the title "Chrysostom" (golden mouthed). They explained the Scriptures with clarity and sometimes went on for hours. Made Bishop of Constantinople in 398, a move that involved him in imperial politics. He criticized the rich for not sharing their wealth and encouraged practices of justice and charity. Twice exiled then banished to Pythius. Proclaimed Doctor of the Church in 451. Patron of Lecturers, preachers, speakers, orators.
