
CONFIRMATION 2024



ticular, with respect to glass or other breakable containers which are not permitted. Nor are wreaths, wreath stands and artificial flowers after April 30 as these infringe on grass cutting operations. Flower beds are restricted to annuals only and are limited to the area formed by the width of the plot and 18 inches in front of the monument. No potted plants or vases are permitted around the columbariums as they infringe on the niches on the bottom of the columbariums. We have received several complaints from families that shrubs and perennials from neighbouring plots are infringing and blocking their plots. In preparation for the upcoming Annual Mass for the Faithful Departed on August 16, we would like our cemetery to look its best and would like to give everyone a chance to ensure by-laws are being followed. After August 6, cemetery staff will be removing any noncompliant plantings, flowers and glass containers.


