

The words from the Gospel of Mark this week are meant to grab our attention. We are reminded that the choices we make for ourselves may impact those around us. If there is something in our lives – some habit, behaviour, attitude – that gets between us and God, we must cut it out. Which choices are leading us to God? Which away from God? What holds us back from living the life God has put within us? If spending way too much time on social media is holding us back from the quiet our souls are longing, perhaps we should cut down that time. If the people we spend time with are

not encouraging the best from us, perhaps we should cut them off too. And let us not be the ones who cause others to stumble either. Let us not prevent others from moving toward God. We need to remember that Jesus came to heal. He did not come to separate, isolate or exclude. Let us not do that to anyone either.

OCTOBER IS ROSARY MONTH The practice of dedicating the entire month of October to the Most Holy Rosary developed toward the

end of the last century. This is primarily due to the fact that the liturgical feast of Our Lady of the Rosary is celebrated annually on **October 7**. It was instituted to honor the Blessed Virgin Mary in gratitude for the protection she gives the Church in answer to the praying of the Rosary by the faithful. Pope Leo XIII (papacy: 1878-1903) strongly promoted the devotion to the Blessed Mother by encouraging the constant use of the Rosary. Please pray the Rosary this month.

NATIONAL DAY FOR TRUTH AND RECONCILIATION September 30 marks the

National Day for Truth and Reconciliation. The day honours Survivors of residential schools and the children who never returned home, as well as their families and communities. Orange shirt day commemorates and raises awareness of the individual, family and community inter-generational impacts of residential schools, and promotes the concept of "Every Child Matters". The orange shirt is a symbol of the stripping away of culture, freedom and self-esteem experienced by Indigenous children over generations. On September 30, we encourage all Canadians to wear orange to honour the thousands of Survivors of res-

idential schools. We pray for all the children who died in residential schools throughout Canada and for all those who continue on a journey through the darkness, that there may be healing founded on truth and that the Spirit will inspire our ongoing commitment to reconciliation. God, through the presence and power of the Holy Spirit, continue to offer us correction so that

your grace might change and transform us in our weakness and repentance. Give us humility to listen when others reveal how we have failed and courage to love others as ourselves, mindful of your love for the weakest and most vulnerable among us. Amen.
