DEVELOPMENT AND PEACE

Development and Peace invites all St. John Chrysostom parishioners to express their commitment to supporting human and environmental rights by signing a petition to the Federal Government after Masses on February 1st/2nd. The petition calls for due diligence legislation for Canadian companies operating abroad. Human rights and environmental abuses continue to devastate the lives of peasant and indigenous farmers in the Global South. Following the D&P "People and the Planet" Campaign in 2021/22, the Federal Government promised to pass due diligence legislation, but this has not happened. Let's remind them through this petition to fulfill their promise.
