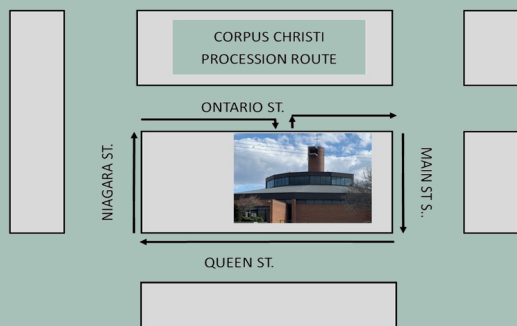
How to Make a Jubilee Pilgrimage or Visit a Jubilee Parish
