The Rock. Strength. Solid. Stable. And the keys? Peter, heads up. When Jesus tossed them to you, He entrusted you with spiritual authority and responsibility—breathing purpose to your call—to lead the Church, to teach, and to make binding decisions on faith and morals. In you, Jesus saw not just the man—but the *foundation*. Not just the fisherman—but the shepherd. In your hands, those keys open more than doors. They open hearts. They open heaven. The Church was not built on sand. It was built on you. The rock.



### SAINTS PETER AND PAUL

With his new name and the spiritual authority of the “keys to the kingdom of heaven,” **Peter** emerged as the Church’s leader after Pentecost. He spent about ten years in Jerusalem preaching, performing miracles, and converting many. He later traveled to Rome, becoming its first bishop. Around 64 AD, Peter was martyred under Emperor Nero and, according to tradition, was crucified upside down out of humility. His tomb lies beneath the main altar of Saint Peter’s Basilica. **Saul**, a Roman citizen from Tarsus, studied under the rabbi Gamaliel in Jerusalem. After Jesus’ ascension, he became a fierce persecutor of Christians and was involved in the stoning of Saint Stephen. On the road to Damascus, he was struck blind and heard Jesus say, “Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting me?” (Acts 9:4). After being baptized by Ananias, Saul spent time in Arabia in prayer and study before returning to Damascus and Jerusalem, where Barnabas testified to the truth of his conversion.
