No money, no supplies, no plan B — just peace in their hearts, healing in their hands, and a quiet trust that God will provide. Jesus asked His disciples to travel light, to release their hold on material things — but He did not tell them to let go of each other. He sent them out two by two — He sends us too, knowing not everyone will receive His message. When rejection comes, we are to shake the dust off our feet and keep going. Because the mission continues, even when it is not received. Our mission is not about being accepted everywhere — it is about being obedient always. Because we are not responsible for the outcome; we are responsible for the going. We may not have all the answers, all the support, or a perfect plan — but if we carry peace, healing, and trust in God's provision, we have enough. And when we walk with one another, we have more than enough.


