items were shipped in July to Gjoa Haven and Talovoak, two remote Arctic communities. The \$11.202 cost was shared by our St. John Chrysostom / St. Elizabeth Seton Conference, with support from Our Lady of Grace (Aurora) and St. Paul the Apostle (Alliston). Special thanks to St. Patrick's Conference for organizing the containers and helping streamline the process. Early sea lane openings allowed for timely delivery, and families received the food soon after arrival. 


SEASON OF CREATION


