They are not scholars, nor religious leaders, nor men of influence. They are simply at work, casting and mending their nets. Like the first disciples, we too, may feel unprepared or unworthy, but "God does not call the qualified; He qualifies the called". The invitation remains the same for all of us. When we respond with trust and obedience, God does the qualifying: shaping our hearts, strengthening our faith, and giving us what we need along the way. We should take comfort that Jesus chose lowly, uneducated fishermen as His first apostles who "...immediately left their nets to follow Him." Today, Jesus still passes by the shores of our daily lives. The question is not whether we are qualified, but whether we are willing to leave our nets and follow Him... because the Lord will always sustain us on that call whatever it may be.

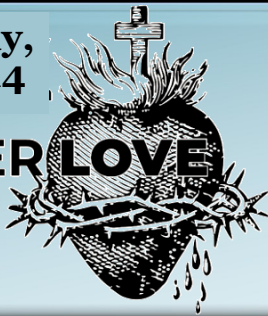

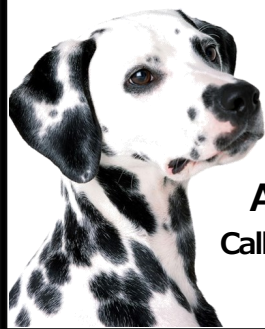

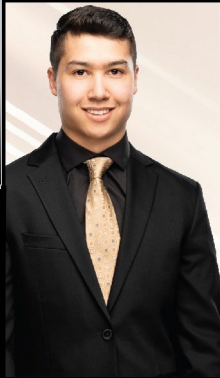
