Office parking lot will be **CLOSED** June 6-7 for the Corpus Christi procession staging. Please use the main parking lot. Thank you.

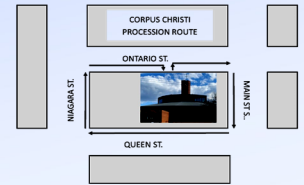
Corpus Christi Mass & Procession
